We are a community-centric organisaiton at the forefront of Prostate Cancer Education and support across regional and rural areas within Queensland and New South Wales.

Our mission is simple – eradiate prostate cancer deaths in Australia. By educating our community about this disease and promoting annual testing for early detection, we intend to turn this mission into a reality.

What does ManUp! Australia do?

Every year, we embark on an extensive 10-month outreach campaign, visiting local communities, mine sites, and corporate organisations to educate men and women about the crucial importance of regular prostate cancer testing. This proactive approach aids in detecting the disease at early, curable stages.

Important Information

When are sessions held?

That's completely up to you! The ManUp! Prostate Cancer Education program can fit in with scheduled training days, health & well-being programs, 'Lunch and Learn' programs, or as special guests at monthly meetings.

As there is quite a high demand for our Prostate Cancer Education Program, we do recommend booking a session in for your preferred date(s) at least 3-6 months in advance.

I have a series of training days over two weeks – are you able to come to each training day? Absolutely! We understand that some organisations need to hold several training days to get through all of their employees. If you require us for several training days over a period of weeks, please contact us 3-6 months in advance to book.

What do I need to provide?

If you have a data projector and screen, we provide the rest! However, if you don't have this, we also travel with our own data projector and screen to suit any space. We also require a small table to put information brochures and flyers on.

Who should attend?

Everyone! While prostate cancer does only occur in men, we find that women also gain a lot of valuable knowledge when they attend one of our education sessions, and they are able to have a conversation with their father, brother, partner, or son.

What does it cost?

We do have a cost structure fee for our Education Program, but the total cost depends on how many times the Prostate Cancer Education Program needs to be delivered.
